It is elaborated to show a general view over the complex activity of the judiciary.





Percentage of non-covered days (PNCD): The total number of days in which positions of a particular category have been left uncovered, divided by the number of staff members in that category multiplied by 365. This is expressed as a percentage.

Rotation index (RI): Number of investitures both of permanent positions and others, divided by the organic staff in the category. This is a measurement of the stability of the staff.




